



Young people ages 13-29 represent **41%** of all new <u>HIV infections</u> in Ohio.



80% of new infections in 2011 were in men.20% were in women.







1 in 5 HIV-positive Ohioans don't know their status.

Blacks account for 48% of new HIV diagnoses, but represent just 12% of Ohio's population.




The rate of persons living with an HIV infection is six times greater among Blacks than whites.

The rate of persons living with an HIV infection was three times greater among Hispanic/Latino Ohioans than whites.
